# C.O.P.E.

## Scheduling and Fees

*The new Council Service Center C.O.P.E. Course is complete and open for program scheduling. The course is open to all Scout units and their Charter Partners. In addition, local youth agencies, other "not-for-profit" agencies, and business groups may schedule the course for program. Scouting units and youth groups will enjoy the fun and adventure of initiative games, low course challenges, a four-station 32 foot climbing wall, and the high ropes course. Adult groups and businesses may schedule time on the course and expert instruction for team building and leadership workshops.*

*In general the course will be open year-round (weather and staff schedule permitting). It will be available for scheduling after 1pm on weekdays and after 8am Saturdays. There will be no programs scheduled on Sunday. The basic program takes at least 2 hours for small troops and other groups. Most units should plan on 3 hours of program. Groups wanting to schedule a leadership conference/training should schedule for either 1/2 day, 1 day, or 2 days of program. A general outline of fees is listed below.*
